# SHOWBIZ BEAUTY

- · Botanically, bananas are considered berries.
- A single banana is called a "finger" and a bunch is called a "hand."
- Worldwide, bananas are the most produced fruit by volume.
- Bananas and plantains both belong to the genus Musa. Plantains are typically larger with a thicker skin than bananas. Sometimes called "cooking bananas," they are starchy and not as sweetperfect for roasting or frying.
- Extend the shelf life of your bananas by popping them in the fridge—it slows the ripening process.
